They had four children: Miles J. 1820, Thomas T. 1822, Jason A. 1824, and Margie A. 1826. Stokeley H. Enochs was born 16 Feb 1796 in Bedford Co., TN and died 18 Nov 1826 in Jackson, Carroll Co., TN. Jane then married Andrew N. Hopkins, who was appointed guardian for her children in 1829. I have not found any marriage dates for either husband.
